



# ALASKA'S CRUISE PACKING LIST

## What to pack for your adventure with Custom Alaska Cruises:

~ The packing list a good guideline to use to not pack too much or too little ~

- Layers are very important in Alaska. Pack multiple layers of short sleeve shirts, long sleeves, vests, fleece, and a lightly insulated jacket.
- Pants: both cozy pants to lounge around the boat in and outdoor pants for excursions. Jeans, fleece pants, etc are fine.
- Bathing Suit for the hot springs or those daring souls that want to swim in our cold waters.
- Shoes: tennis shoes are fine, we suggest a water proof or water resistant outdoor shoe for beach excursions, hikes, (keens, bogs, etc.)
- Rain apparel: lightweight pull over rain pants and jacket for outdoor excursions on rainy days
- Lightweight gloves for those chillier days
- Outdoor warm hat
- We provide toiletries/linens just like a hotel would: such as shampoo, conditioner, soap, hand soaps, towels, hand towels, wash clothes, makeup remover wipes & hair dryers; we suggest you bring other items needed.
- Sun Block and Bug Spray
- The boats are equipped with 110v outlets throughout.
- We suggest a soft daypack for your hikes
- Sunglasses for those beautiful sunny days on the water!
- Binoculars, although we have some aboard too for your enjoyment
- Cameras, batteries, extra memory cards
